WEEK FOUR: ACTS 11:19-30

Check in with your LifeGroup to see how everyone is doing and what needs have come up.

What impacted you the most from this week's sermon? Was anything challenging about the sermon?

Read Proverbs 13:12. Is there anything you are hoping for that you feel like has been put on hold? Pray for those things as a group.

Read Acts 11:22-24. What does this passage say about Barnabas that sets him apart? What would it look like for us to become more like Barnabas? How can we remind ourselves to be encouragers this week?

The Church remained generous throughout these hardships and that helped provide for everyone. Cedarcrest has already put generosity on display for our community this past week. **What are other ways we can look for opportunities to serve in a chaotic season?**

Read Acts 13:1-3. We worship always, especially when things are uncertain. **Is it easy or difficult for you to worship in seasons like this? Why? How can your LifeGroup help you worship in this season?** (Remember ACTS → Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication)

As the Church experienced hardships, they leaned in to their relationship with Jesus. **Have you ever practiced Worship, Word, and Whisper before? How did that go? Are you willing to try that model this week to see what God does in you?**

You were created for something greater than yourself. **How do you think God is using you in the mission of the Church? What has He been speaking to you over the past week?**
